Voting in the district and parish council elections on Thursday 4 May is different this

year with the introduction of photo I.D.

Anyone who wants to vote in the local elections will need to present an accepted form of photo I.D.

I don't have photo I.D.

Don't worry – you will still be able to vote. You'll need to apply for a Voter Authority Certificate.

You can apply <u>online</u> or you can complete a paper application form and send to NWLDC.

To apply for a Voter Authority Certificate, you will need to provide your:

Name | Address | Date of birth | National Insurance Number

You'll also need to submit a photograph with your application, with similar requirements as for a passport photo.

King's Coronation Grant

The Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III will take place on Saturday 6 May 2023, with an additional bank holiday on Monday 8 May 2023.
