For the Resident fee to apply the deceased must have been residing in the parish of Osgathorpe at the time of their death. Evidence of residency in the parish shall be provided by the Funeral Director / applicant.

For the Non – Resident fee to apply the deceased must have resided in the parish of Osgathorpe for a reasonable period prior to the date of their death. Evidence of prior residency in the parish shall be provided by the Funeral Director / applicant.

For persons residing in the parish of Osgathorpe on or before 1 April 2023, and wishing to apply to pre-arrange and pay for internment and exclusive rights to burial, the fees to be applied will need to be agreed with Osgathorpe Parish Council before 1 April 2024. The minimum fee in this instance shall be equivalent to the Resident fees, payable within one month of the agreement, and subject to increase due to inflation. The final fees due shall be determined by the Parish Council at the time of the applicant's death.
