UK SPF Fund

Voluntary and community groups are invited to apply for funding from the **UK** Shared Prosperity Fund (SPF Fund) to support work that improves and enhances their local area. Applications close on 30 June 2023 so please start planning your project now.

All areas across the district are allocated funding from the grant, with community groups, parish and town councils and voluntary



organisations able to bid for some, or all, of the funding for a project.

Funding pots will be available for 2022/23 and 2023/24, with £150,000 available for the district each year. Communities have been assigned funds of between £3,000 and £10,000 each, depending on population size.

<u>'Food Hubs' grant for Community</u> <u>Fridges</u>

Hubbub has further funding available for community fridges to develop 'Food hub' activities. Funding of up to £7k is available to each of up to 50 community fridges. Deadline for applications is 31 May 2023.

Local School Nature Grants

Learning Through Landscapes is providing nature equipment grants of up to £500 to nurseries, pre-schools and also primary and secondary schools. Not open to PTAs or 'Friends of' groups. Deadline for next round is 9 June 2023.

National Grid - Green Spaces Community Fund

With Spring having finally sprung, National Grid is offering grants to support communities to enhance their local environments and encourage more people to make the most of their green spaces. Registered charities and grassroots organisations can apply for up to £10k, while constituted charitable organisations with no charity number can apply for up to £2k. Deadline for applications is 12 May 2023.

BIFFA Partnership Grants

Grants of between £250k and £1million are available to support capital projects that address either of the following themes (the project must not cross over the two themes):

- Built environment projects
- Natural environment projects Organisations must be eligible to enrol with ENTRUST as an Environmental Body. Deadline for expression of interest is 1 June 2023.

Benefact Trust - Building Improvements Grants

Grants are available for Christian charities, churches, cathedrals, and denominational bodies across the UK to support the conservation, preservation, or aesthetic enhancement of Christian churches and charity buildings.
